5.	<b>Description of content:</b>  The animal health regulations control the importation of processed products of artiodactylus animal into the Republic of Korea from Austria in order to prevent the introduction of disease and food-poison that could have a serious effect on the Republic of Korea's nation and agriculture.  For the products to be imported into Korea - there shall not have occurred Foot-and-Mouth Disease, Rinderpest, Contagious Pleuropneumonia, Swine Vesicular Disease, BSE and Scrapie in Austria - there shall not have occurred Classical Swine Fever, Anthrax and Tuberculosis in the area where the processing plant is located.
