The following communication by the Philippines is being circulated.

Temporary Ban on the Importation of FMD Susceptible Animals, their Meat, Meat Products and By-Products Originating from the United Kingdom

Department of Agriculture (DA) Memorandum Order (MO) No. 1, Series of 2002, lifts the temporary ban on the importation of live pigs, semen, pork, pork products and by-products from the United Kingdom, subject to certain conditions contained in the said MO.

The temporary ban was instituted through DA MO No. 4, Series of 2001 and notified to WTO Members on 23 March 2001.

The temporary ban is lifted effective 5 February 2002, following recognition of the Office international des Epizooties (OIE) of the restoration of foot-and-mouth disease (FMD)-free status without vaccination in the United Kingdom.
