The Textiles Monitoring Body has received a further notification from El Salvador pursuant to paragraphs 8(a) and 11 of Article 2.

Sir,

With reference to your note TMB/100, asking us for further details concerning percentages and the classification thereof, I wish to inform you that until February 1993 our foreign trade was classified using the Central American Tariff Nomenclature (NAUCA). For the purposes of fulfilling the commitment of integrating textiles into the WTO framework, this system had to be converted to the corresponding classification of the Central American Tariff System (SAC), which is the same as the classification used worldwide.

As for the integration of Item 42.02.92.00, we have reviewed our originals and found that this was an involuntary error which we have now corrected. The correct item is **52.07.90.00 - OTHER COTTON YARN PUT UP FOR RETAIL SALE**. The volume remains the same, i.e. 6,923 kilos. All the remainder, concerning both the first and the second integration of textiles, remains entirely unchanged.
