Dear Ambassador Szepesi,

Pursuant to Article 2.2 of the Agreement on Textiles and Clothing (ATC), and with reference to the notification (G/TMB/N/432) submitted by Turkey under Article 2.1 of the ATC and circulated by TMB on 14 March 2002, our mission would like to submit our observations as below:

In compliance with Article 2.1 of ATC and paragraph 167 of the Report of the Working Party on the Accession of Chinese Taipei, we regard it appropriate to make the following amendments in the document of G/TMB/N/432:

1. Annex II (Flexibility Provisions):
  - Delete Group IV, which is not applicable to our restriction, both in the sixth subparagraph and in column 7 of the table of flexibility provisions on page 6.
2. Annex III (Product Classification):
  - Delete Annex IA, which is not applicable to our restriction, on page 21.
