6.	Description of content: This standard specifies the information to be included on labels of household and automotive cleaning chemicals. It specifies the information to be included on individual packages, collective units of such packages and instruction leaflets accompanying the packages. The standard applies to laundry and other detergents, waxes, polishes, solvents, disinfectants, sanitizers and pads containing a cleaning chemical. This standard does not apply to the labelling of cosmetics and cleaning chemicals primarily intended for use on human beings.
7.	Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: Compulsory status has been recommended in order to protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety and to prevent deception arising from misleading advertising or labelling.
