**NOTIFICATION UNDER PARAGRAPH 2 OF ANNEX III TO THE
AGREEMENT ON IMPLEMENTATION OF ARTICLE VII
OF THE GENERAL AGREEMENT
ON TARIFFS AND TRADE 1994**

COLOMBIA

The following communication, dated 24 July 2002, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Colombia.

With regard to paragraph 1 of the Decision concerning the reservation by Colombia under paragraph 2 of Annex III to the Agreement on Implementation of Article VII of the GATT 1994 (Document G/VAL/26), I wish to inform you that the Customs Directorate has issued the following instruments pursuant to this Decision:

1. Memorandum No. 0290 of the Technical Branch of the Customs Directorate, notifying the bodies responsible for the implementation of the Agreement on Customs Valuation that minimum prices will cease to apply to the agricultural sector tariff subheadings listed in Annex II to Decision G/VAL/26 as of 1 May 2002.
2. Resolution No. 7009 of 19 July 2002, whereby the Director of Customs repeals Resolution No. 5533 of 19 June 2001 establishing the minimum prices to be applied to the footwear subheadings listed in Annex II to Decision G/VAL/26.

Furthermore, we hereby certify that Colombia has not applied minimum values to additional products nor amended the data sources or methodologies for determining the minimum values allowed under Annex III to Decision G/VAL/26.
