By means of a communication from its delegation, dated 5 April 2001, Panama has notified its other laws and regulations under Article 63.2 of the TRIPS Agreement and pursuant to the footnote of document IP/N/1/PAN/1, as follows.

I have the honour to transmit herewith, on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Panama and pursuant to the footnote of Panama's Notification circulated as document IP/N/1/PAN/1 of 1 July 1998, the following notification concerning the implementation of the Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (TRIPS):

 - Law No. 18 of 22 September 1918 adopting the Criminal Code of the Republic of Panama.
