NOTIFICATION UNDER PARAGRAPH 1 OF THE UNDERSTANDING  
ON THE BALANCE-OF-PAYMENTS PROVISIONS OF THE  
GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE 1994

The following notification, dated 14 July 1997, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Nigeria.

I have the honour to forward herewith, for circulation to Members of the Committee, the eight-year time schedule proposed by Nigeria for the removal of the remaining items under import prohibition. The attached timetable was discussed with interested delegations on 27 May 1997 here in Geneva.

PROPOSED TIME SCHEDULE FOR THE REMOVAL OF THE ITEMS  
ON THE IMPORT PROHIBITION LIST

1999	Beer and stout (HS.2203.000).
2000	Live or dead poultry (i.e. fowls, ducks, geese, turkeys and guinea fowls) (HS.0105.1100-9900; 0106.0000; 0207.1100-3600); Domestic articles and wares made of plastic materials (HS.3922.1000- 3922.9000; 3924.1000-3924.9000), excluding babies' feeding bottles.
2001	Wheat flour (H.S. 1101.0000).
2002	Vegetable oils, excluding linseed and castor oils used as industrial raw materials (HS.1515.1100; 1515.1900; and 1515.3000).
2003	Evian and similar waters (HS.2201.1000-2202.9000); Millet (HS.1008.2000); Sorghum (HS.1007.0000).
2004	Gypsum (SH.2520.1000).
2005	Maize (HS.1005.1000-1005.9000); Barytes (HS.2511.1100-2511.2000); Kaolin (2507.0000).
