

**MARRAKESH AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING  
THE WORLD TRADE ORGANIZATION**

Withdrawal of Invocation of Article XIII by the United States with respect to the Kyrgyz Republic

In a communication dated 18 September 2000 the Ambassador of the United States to the World Trade Organization has notified the Chairman of the General Council that the United States has disinvoked the provisions of Article XIII of the above-mentioned Agreement with respect to the Kyrgyz Republic. The text of the communication is as follows.

By letter of 9 October 1998 the Permanent Representative of the United States to the World Trade Organization notified the Chairman of the WTO General Council that the United States of America did not consent to the application as between it and the Kyrgyz Republic of the *Marrakesh Agreement Establishing the World Trade Organization* and the Multilateral Trade Agreements in Annexes 1 and 2 thereto. My authorities have now instructed me to inform the General Council that the United States has disinvoked the provisions of Article XIII of the Marrakesh Agreement. Therefore, the United States has consented to the application as between it and the Kyrgyz Republic of the *Marrakesh Agreement Establishing the World Trade Organization* and the Multilateral Trade Agreements in Annexes 1 and 2 thereto.
