**NOTIFICATION OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS UNDER  
ARTICLES 18.5 AND 32.6 OF THE AGREEMENTS**

Questions Posed by TURKEY  
Regarding the Notification of PANAMA<sup>1</sup>

The following communication, dated 5 October 1998, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Turkey.

Q1. Referring to Article 75.2 of Law No. 29 of 1 February 1996, could you please clarify how the Panamanian authorities determine whether the price of the identical or similar product when exported to a third country is representative or not? Could you please elaborate more on the "representative price" as stated in the second paragraph of Article 75.2 of the cited law?

Q2. As regards Article 89 of Law No. 29 of 1 February 1996, could the Panamanian authorities explain whether the amendment of the final resolution to extend the existing measure to the products coming from a third country takes place after an investigation has been conducted on the issue of evasion or is this purely an administrative decision that does not necessarily follow an investigation? If an investigation is needed before the amendment of the final resolution, is it conducted on an expedited basis?
