NOTIFICATION

The following notification in the context of export subsidy commitments (Tables ES:1 and ES:3) for the year 1995 was received from the delegation of Cuba on 22 September 1997.

In accordance with the provisions of the World Trade Organization and as provided for by the Committee on Agriculture in document G/AG/2, Cuba hereby notifies that it did not apply any export subsidies to agricultural products during the period 1 January-31 December 1995. Cuba wishes to state that given the necessary economic changes under way in the country, changes are taking place in its policy, which is being systematically reviewed to ensure that it is in conformity with the WTO Agreements. Cuba intends to keep the Committee on Agriculture informed should any measure it adopts so require, in compliance with its commitments under the Agreement.
