4.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Adoption of emergency measures to ensure the phytosanitary protection of plants and vegetable products imported from Colombia (2 pages)
5.	Description of content: The Departmental Resolution stipulates that the host plants and vegetable products of the above-mentioned species of <i>thrips</i> imported from Colombia into Peru must come from areas free from such pests.
