<b>5. Title, language and number of pages of the notified document:</b> Authorization to issue animal health import permits for imports of live birds and other products from Belgium and establishments in the USA that are unaffected by the avian influenza virus, (1 page, in Spanish).
<b>6. Description of content:</b> Authorizes the issuance of animal health import permits for live birds (commercial birds, backyard poultry, fighting birds, wildfowl and ornamental cage birds), fertile eggs, eggs for consumption, poultry meat, other poultry products and by-products from Belgium.  Authorizes the issuance of animal health import permits for imports of live birds, fertile eggs, eggs for consumption, poultry meat, other poultry products and by-products from export-registered establishments participating in the National Poultry Improvement Plan, from states of the United States of America where no outbreaks of avian influenza have been reported during the two (2) years prior to the date of publication of this Resolution.  Maintains the import ban on live birds (commercial birds, backyard poultry, fighting birds, wildfowl and ornamental cage birds), fertile eggs, eggs for consumption, poultry meat, other poultry products and by-products from the following countries: Cambodia; Canada; People's Republic of China; Republic of Korea; Hong Kong (Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China); Indonesia; Japan; Laos; Pakistan; Chinese Taipei; Thailand; Viet Nam and the states of California, Connecticut, Rhode Island, Pennsylvania, Texas, Delaware, New Jersey and Maryland of the United States of America (USA).

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	Permits imports of certain low-risk products of poultry origin that meet the animal health standards established by SENASA, including processing to ensure destruction of the avian influenza virus.
