### NOTIFICATION

#### Corrigendum

In the notification by the United States dated 9 January 2003 (document G/SPS/N/USA/659), point 6 (Description of content) should read as follows:

This regulation establishes tolerances for residues of spinosad in or on fig at 0.10 part per million (ppm); herb, fresh, subgroup at 3.0 ppm; herb, dried, subgroup at 22 ppm; vegetable, root and tuber, group at 0.10 ppm; caneberry subgroup at 0.70 ppm; grape at 0.50 ppm; grape, raisin at 0.70 ppm; peanut at 0.02 ppm; and beet, sugar, molasses at 0.75 ppm. This regulation also increases established tolerances for cattle, meat to 0.50 ppm; cattle, meat byproducts to 2.0 ppm; cattle, fat to 6.5 ppm; milk to 2.5 ppm; and milk, fat to 27 ppm. These tolerances were requested under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FFDCA), as amended by the Food Quality Protection Act (FQPA) of 1996.
