The following communication, dated 24 February 2004, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the United States.

Interim Final Rule; Correction; Regulation Implementing Title III of the Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act of 2002; Section 307: Prior Notice of Imported Food Shipments (Docket. No. 2002N-0278)

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is correcting an interim final rule that appeared in the **Federal Register** of 10 October 2003 (68 FR 58974). The document issued an interim final regulation that requires the submission to FDA of prior notice of food, including animal feed, which is imported or offered for import into the United States. The document was published with some minor typographical and citation errors. A second document published 2 February 2004 (69 FR 4851) corrected those errors and made other non-substantive clarifying changes. This document published on 24 February 2004, corrects a typographical error in a web site address referenced in the document published on 2 February 2004.
