Addendum

The present document reproduces the updated information on Norway's technical and financial cooperation activities relevant to the implementation of the TRIPS Agreement, which has been received from the Permanent Mission of Norway by means of a communication dated 4 November 2003.

In collaboration with the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), the Norwegian Patent Office has held one basic two-week course on intellectual property rights annually since 2000. These courses have been attended by around 20 participants from national industrial property offices in developing countries. The courses have been financed by the Norwegian Patent Office and are free of charge for the participants. Travel costs have been covered by WIPO, which has also handled applications from potential participants.

The course is intended for officials who deal with intellectual property on a practical level, and aims to give them a better understanding of intellectual property rights, giving special attention to the administration of such rights. The courses have focused either on patents or on trademarks. This year the topic was trademarks. The language of instruction is English. Similar courses are planned for the years ahead.
