PROTECTION OF NEW PLANT VARIETIES
ORDER, 2001

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 5 of the *Protection of New Plant Varieties Act* makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Protection of New Plant Varieties Order, 2001*.

2. The *Protection of New Plant Varieties Act* applies to the genera and species specified in the *Schedule* hereto.
