Questions Posed by HUNGARY
Regarding the Notification of EGYPT¹

The following communication, dated 13 April 2000, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Hungary.

1. What were the unforeseen developments in the sense of Article XIX:1(a) that led to the increase in imports?
 2. How did the Egyptian authorities establish that there was a causal relationship between the increase in imports and the decline in the relevant injury factors and that their parallel inverse movement was not coincidental?
 3. Please provide us with the yearly import figures for the period 1996-99.
 4. Could you include a breakdown of the import figures according to the different types of lamps subject to the safeguard measure?
 5. Please provide yearly data concerning the share of imports relative to domestic production during the above-mentioned period?
 6. Could you please supplement the overview of the situation of the domestic industry during the above-mentioned period with more detailed information and illustrate it with statistics on a yearly basis, with particular regard to the inventories?
