Addendum

The following communication, dated 2 July 2004, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Colombia.

Health-related measures to prevent the introduction into Colombia of avian influenza: processed meat products of avian origin

The health measures notified in documents G/SPS/N/COL/82 of 15 April 2004 and G/SPS/N/COL/82/Add.1 of 20 April 2004 have been amended pursuant to Colombian Agricultural Institute (ICA) Resolution No. 01103 of 9 June 2004, to the effect that the entry into Colombia of one-day-old chicks, fertile eggs, eggs for consumption and live poultry from export-registered farms registered with the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA), poultry meat, meat products and other products of avian origin for industrial use will be permitted from Canadian provinces where no outbreaks of highly pathogenic or low-pathogenic avian influenza viruses of the H5 or H7 subtypes have been reported during the two years immediately prior to the date of publication of this Resolution.
