The following communication by the United States is being circulated.

Lysophosphatidylethanolamine (LPE); Exemption from the Requirement of a Tolerance

This Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulation (final rule) establishes an exemption from the requirement of a tolerance for residues of the biological pesticide lysophosphatidylethanolamine (LPE) on all food commodities when applied/used in accordance with good agricultural practices. The petitioner submitted a petition to EPA under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, as amended by the Food Quality Protection Act of 1996, requesting an exemption from the requirement of a tolerance. This regulation eliminates the need to establish a maximum permissible level for residues of LPE.

This regulation is effective 11 April 2002. Objections and requests for hearings must be received by EPA, on or before 10 June 2002.
