Registration of Food Facilities Under the Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act of 2002; Technical Amendment

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is correcting a notice of the interim final rulemaking ("the interim final rule") that appeared in the Federal Register of 10 October 2003 (68 FR 5378). The interim final rule requires domestic and foreign facilities that manufacture/process, pack, or hold food for human or animal consumption in the United States to register with FDA by 12 December 2003. Due to several inadvertent errors in 21 CFR §§ 1.231 and 1.232, the interim final rule contains some incorrect information. This document corrects those errors.
