The following communication by Canada is being circulated in accordance with Article 10.6.

Nutrition Labelling, Nutrient Content Claims and Health Claims: Proposed Compliance Test to Assess the Accuracy of Nutrient Values. Consultation Document.

The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) is responsible for enforcing the proposed new *Food and Drug Regulations* for mandatory nutrition labelling on pre-packaged food and for requirements for voluntary nutrition and health claims notified by the Department of Health in June 2001.

The compliance test proposed in this consultation document describes a set of conditions that would, if adopted, constitute the CFIA methodology for assessing the accuracy of nutrition labelling and claims via sampling and laboratory analysis. Comments are requested by January 15, 2003.
