<b>6.</b>	<b>Description of content:</b> This Specification gives the minimum colour coding and labelling requirements for the identification of the contents of piping, pipelines, ducts and conduits.  The methods for identification in this standard are as follows:  (a) Marking and labelling; (b) basic identification colours only; (c) basic identification colours and code indications; and (d) basic identification colours used in conjunction with the user's colour coding scheme.
<b>7.</b>	<b>Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:</b> Compulsory status has been recommended to minimize potential hazards that may be the result of insufficient identification of the contents of various types of domestic and industrial pipelines, piping, ducts and conduits.
