6.	<p>Description of content: The purpose of this Mexican Official Standard is to establish the mechanical and electrical requirements and the methods for testing the minimum technical parameters to be satisfied by any terminal equipment connected or interconnected to the Mexican public telecommunications network.</p> <p>The technical requirements for terminal equipment cover the following aspects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) prevention of any damage to the public telecommunications networks or deterioration of the services provided;(b) prevention of electromagnetic interference affecting the telecommunications networks and users of the radio-frequency spectrum;(c) electromagnetic compatability with other users of the radio-frequency spectrum;(d) safety of operators and the public in general (insofar as not provided for in other laws or regulations);(e) interoperability with the public telecommunications networks;(f) efficient use of the radio-frequency spectrum, when appropriate;(g) prevention of malfunctioning of the charging, collecting and invoicing equipment. <p>This Standard is applicable to any device connected or interconnected to a network terminal connection point, known as terminal equipment.</p>
