Assistance by budget.

6. Form of the subsidy

Grant.

7. To whom and how the subsidy is provided

Subsidy is provided to severe loss-making State-owned enterprises due to either fixed price of the products they produce or the increasing cost of exploitation of the resources.

8. Subsidy per unit, or in cases where this is not possible, the total amount or the annual amount budgeted for that subsidy

Note

1. China sets a base for 21% reduction by volume for coarse grain and rice. The base for reduction by value remains the same as our schedule submitted in September 1994.
2. As to the export subsidies for oil seed, vegetable oil, oil cake, sugar, pork, poultry meat, live animal, cotton and tea, China commits itself to make a reduction of 36% by value and 21% by volume. This is beyond the 24% cut by value and 14% cut by volume as required by the Agreement on Agriculture for developing countries.
3. China commits itself to eliminate export subsidies for wheat, milk powder, other milk products, beef, goat/sheep, eggs, wine, fruits, canned fruits, vegetable and cigarettes.
4. Implementation period for China's reduction commitments is 6 years. The first year of implementation starts upon entry into force of the Protocol, and the reduction will be carried out in equal instalment through the six years.
