TRANSPARENCY AND DERESTRICTION

Communication from the United States

The following communication, dated 6 February 1998, has been received from the Permanent Mission of the United States.

At the last General Council meeting, the Director General provided delegations with an update of Secretariat activities related to transparency, in particular, the progress in using the Internet and creation of the WTO Home Page. The United States wishes to inscribe on the Council's agenda a point on transparency, where we would intend to focus on how the decision taken by the General Council with respect to derestriction (WT/L/160/Rev.1) is operating and whether there are additional issues that the Council will need to consider in this area in order to improve the operation of the WTO.
