**NOTIFICATION CONCERNING THE TIME-PERIOD FOR DETERMINATION
OF NEGLIGIBLE IMPORT VOLUMES UNDER
ARTICLE 5.8 OF THE AGREEMENT**

VENEZUELA

The following communication, dated 24 March 2003, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Venezuela.

I have pleasure in submitting herewith the notification concerning the time-period to be considered in making a determination of negligible import volumes for purposes of Article 5.8 of the Anti-Dumping Agreement.

On 27 November 2002, the Committee on Anti-Dumping Practices adopted a recommendation concerning the time-period to be considered in making a determination of negligible import volumes for purposes of Article 5.8 of the Anti-Dumping Agreement (circulated as document G/ADP/10). The recommendation requires members to notify the Committee on Anti-Dumping Practices which of the time-periods set out therein they will use thereafter in the determination of negligible import volumes.

In this regard, Venezuela wishes to notify that it will use the period of data collection for the dumping investigation, namely, the methodology set out in subparagraph (a) of the Recommendation.
