## **RECTIFICATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS OF SCHEDULES**

### Schedule XII – India

The following communication, dated 20 April 2000, has been received from the Permanent Mission of India.

Pursuant to the reports by India on the conclusion of negotiations and related consultations by India in respect of its proposal to increase existing bindings in relation to certain products in Schedule XII through Article XXVIII:1 of the GATT 1994, circulated in document G/SECRET/8/Add.1 dated 20 January 2000, enclosed herewith<sup>1</sup>, with paragraph 1 of the Decision for *Procedures for Modification and Rectification of Schedules of Tariff Concessions* (L/4962 of 26 March 1980), is a draft of changes in the authentic text of India's Schedule XII to reflect the modifications resulting from the action under Article XXVIII:1.

If no objection is notified to the Secretariat within three months from the date of this document, the rectifications and modifications to Schedule XII – India will be deemed to be approved and will be formally certified.
