CODES AND NOTATIONS

Provisional Measures (Column 4): Provisional measures apply from the date of a preliminary determination of subsidizing to the date on which the Canadian International Trade Tribunal makes its finding regarding injury caused to the Canadian industry (maximum 120 days from the notice of the preliminary determination). The estimated amount of the subsidy is normally expressed as an amount per unit.

Definitive Duties (Column 5): Either the date of a positive injury finding, in the case of an investigation, or the date of the conclusion of a review of injury; or the date of the conclusion of a review of the amount of subsidy in cases where there is an existing Canadian International Trade Tribunal finding of injury.

Total Trade Volume (Column 11): The total trade volume is based on statistical data for the latest available 12 month period prior to the initiation, unless otherwise indicated.

CF: denotes Confidential. The information provided to the authorities is given on a confidential basis or the results of a calculation would disclose information provided on a confidential basis.

R: This symbol has been used in the context of a review of an existing countervailing measure.

The symbol **R(1)** refers to an administrative review of the amount of subsidy of an existing countervailing measure.

The symbol **R(2)** refers to a review of injury of an existing countervailing measure to determine whether the measure should be continued.
