4.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Proposed Amendment to the Food and Drug Regulations (1065) (pages 1251-1253)
5.	Description of content: Procymidone is a systemic fungicide used in the control of the grape disease Botrytis cinerea. It is not currently registered under the Pest Control Products Act for use in Canada since Botrytis cinerea is not a problem in North America grape growing regions. After the review of all available data, it is proposed to amend the Food and Drug Regulations to establish MRLs for procymidone in raisins at 25.0 ppm, in grapes at 5.0 ppm and in wine at 1.0 ppm.
6.	Objective and rationale: protection of human health
