Plants and vegetable products considered to be hosts of <i>Thrips palmi</i> . Regions or countries likely to be affected, to the extent relevant or practicable: Colombia
4.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Abolishes the Rules Governing the Importation of Vegetable Products Hosting <i>Thrips palmi</i> and Other Thrips Imported from Colombia (1 page)
5.	Description of content: This Resolution abolishes Departmental Resolution No. 077-99-AG-SENASA (G/SPS/N/PER/12), which stipulated that imports of plants and vegetable products considered to be hosts of <i>Thrips palmi</i> and other thrips species must come from areas declared to be free of such pests by the Colombian Agricultural Institute (ICA) and approved by the National Agrarian Health Service (SENASA). However, this Resolution does not provide exemption from other phytosanitary import requirements established for plants and vegetable products hosting species of thrips and other A1 quarantine pests for Peru.
