The following communication, dated 12 June 2002, has been received from the United States.

#### Triflurosulfuron Methyl; Pesticide Tolerance

This Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulation (final rule) establishes tolerances for residues of triflurosulfuron methyl in or on beet, sugar, roots; beet, sugar, tops; and chicory, roots. The petitioners requested these tolerances under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FFDCA), as amended by the Food Quality Protection Act of 1996 (FQPA).

This regulation (final rule) is effective 12 June 2002. Objections and requests for hearings must be received on or before 12 August 2002. The full text of this addendum (final rule), including instructions for submitting objections and requests for hearings, is available from the address below.
