### Addendum

The following communication, received on 10 June 2004, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the United States.

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#### Indoxacarb; Time-Limited Pesticide Tolerance

This regulation establishes a time-limited tolerance for residues/combined residues of indoxacarb in or on cherry, sweet and cherry, tart. The tolerance will expire on 21 May 2007.

This regulation is effective 19 May 2004. Objections and requests for hearings must be received on or before 19 July 2004.

In the Federal Register of 17 March 2004 ([69 FR 12664-12670](#)) (FRL-7345-2), EPA issued a notice announcing the filing of a pesticide petition (PP 3G6797) by E.I. DuPont de Nemours and Company, DuPont Crop Protection, Wilmington, DE. This notice included a summary of the petition prepared by DuPont, the registrant.
