RSS-195 sets out the minimum requirements for the certification of transmitters and receivers built by equipment manufacturers.  Notice is also given that Industry Canada is amending the following Radio Standard Specification (RSS). The amended version is:  RSS-192, Issue 2, Fixed Wireless Access Equipment Operating in the Band 3 450-3 650 MHz.  RSS-192 sets out the minimum requirements for the certification of transmitters and receivers built by equipment manufacturers.
