QUESTIONS CONCERNING THE NOTIFICATIONS PROVIDED
BY BRAZIL¹ OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS UNDER
ARTICLES 18.5 AND 32.6 OF THE AGREEMENTS

The following communication, dated 26 October 1995, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Venezuela.

1. *Order of precedence*

Please indicate the purpose of each of the texts notified to the Committee (Decree No. 1355, Provisional Measure No. 926, future Regulation) and their order of precedence.

2. *Implementation of the Agreements*

Is it intended to introduce new instruments to implement all the obligations entered into under the WTO Anti-Dumping and Subsidies Agreements?

3. *Regulation on Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Measures*

Could the Government of Brazil indicate when it will be able to notify to the Committee the new Regulation on measures to avoid the effects of unfair trade practices?

4. *Judicial review*

The notified legislation does not include specific provisions on judicial review of final determinations. In the absence of any express provisions, how will Brazil ensure fulfilment of the obligations set out in Articles 13 of the Anti-Dumping Agreement and 23 of the Agreement on Subsidies? Please describe the procedures to obtain judicial review for each type of decision, provisional and definitive.
