QUESTIONS CONCERNING THE NOTIFICATIONS PROVIDED
BY THE GOVERNMENT OF SURINAME¹ OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS
UNDER ARTICLES 18.5 AND 32.6 OF THE AGREEMENTS

The following communication, dated 16 November 1995, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Hong Kong.

1. Suriname's notification states that Suriname does not have any relevant legislation regarding A-D matters and that dumping practices are a rare phenomena in Suriname's economy.

Questions :

- (a) What is the legal status of the WTO A-D Agreement in the Suriname's legal system? Does it have the force of law?
- (b) Does Suriname contemplate any use of A-D measures in certain circumstances? If so, what is the legal basis on which the relevant authorities may do so ?
- (c) Does Suriname contemplate any enactment of domestic legislation on A-D matters in future?
