REPLIES TO QUESTIONS POSED BY ARGENTINA¹ TO BOLIVIA
CONCERNING THE LATTER'S NOTIFICATION² OF LAWS
AND REGULATIONS UNDER ARTICLES 18.5
AND 32.6 OF THE AGREEMENTS

The following communication, dated 17 April 1996, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Bolivia.

-
- (e) The period stipulated in the national legislation refers to working days (20 working days, which corresponds to 30 calendar days), and therefore there is no contradiction with the provisions of the WTO Agreement.
 - (f) Bolivia has began the revision of the anti-dumping and subsidies legislation in order to bring it into conformity with the WTO.
 - (g) The question is not clear; the national legislation does not allow price undertakings.
 - (h) The revision of the national legislation includes bringing it fully into conformity with the WTO provisions (including definitions, time-periods, procedures, etc.).
