

NOTIFICATION OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS
UNDER ARTICLE 32.6 OF THE AGREEMENT

HONDURAS

The following communication, dated 15 March 1995, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Honduras.

Pursuant to Article 32.6 of the WTO Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures, and the agreement reached by the Informal Contact Group on Anti-Dumping, Subsidies and Safeguards approved by the Preparatory Committee for the WTO in connection with the notifications WTO Members are required to make about their laws and regulations relating to subsidies and countervailing measures, the Government of the Republic of Honduras hereby officially notifies the Committee on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures that, as from the date when the ratification of the Agreement Establishing the World Trade Organization is published in the Official Gazette of Honduras, the WTO Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures will become national law.

The Government of Honduras also wishes to state that it applies the Central American Regulations on Unfair Business Practices and Safeguard Clause, an instrument which is being reviewed at the Central American level to adjust it to the Agreement in question. Once the final version of the Regulations, which will contain provisions in keeping with the Agreement, becomes available, a copy will be forwarded to the Secretariat for the information of WTO Members.
