7.	Objective and rationale: The Dutch Government has recently introduced a policy to promote market forces, deregulation and legislative quality. Within this framework, existing regulations are being scrutinized, including the Commodities Act Order on Fire Safety for Nightwear. The Commodities Act Order on Fire Safety for Nightwear is being suspended until further notice, pending the results of the aforementioned policy.
