Dear Mr. Chairman,

I have the honour to refer to your letter of 9 February 1996 (Ref: A/TMB/402.6) concerning the notification made by Cyprus under the provisions of Articles 2.6 and 2.7(b) of the Agreement on Textiles and Clothing (ATC) and to submit the following additional information.

The notification submitted by Cyprus included all statistical information in value terms due to the lack of a common unit of measurement in Cyprus' statistics as regards the tariff headings of the products included in the Annex of the ATC. More specifically volume terms included in Cyprus' statistics make use of either the kilogram (kg.) or the square metre (m<sup>2</sup>) as the unit of measurement, whereas there are a number of products where statistics are only available in value terms. This differentiation of the unit of measurement used makes the calculation of the total volume quite impossible unless value terms for all products are used.

I trust that the above explanation provides a satisfactory answer to the observations put forward by the TMB.
