I have the honour to hereby notify to the Textiles Monitoring Body, under Article 2(1) of the Agreement on Textiles and Clothing, the quantitative restrictions maintained by the European Community under the said Article. This notification covers only those restrictions vis-à-vis contracting parties which are members of the World Trade Organization and which therefore benefit from the provisions of Article 2 of the Agreement on Textiles and Clothing.

The notification comprises three elements:

- Annex I Quantitative Restrictions (Part 1 Direct quotas and Part 2 OPT quotas);
- Annex II Flexibility provisions;
- Annex III Product classification.

ANNEX II

Flexibility provisions

DIRECT QUANTITATIVE LIMITS

The attached table indicates for each of the supplier countries listed in Column 1 the maximum amounts which, after advance notification to the Commission, it may transfer between the corresponding direct quantitative limits indicated in Annex I (Part 1) in accordance with the following provisions:

- advance utilization of the quantitative limit for the particular category established for the following quota year shall be authorized up to the percentage of the quantitative limit for the current year indicated in Column 2; the amounts in question shall be deducted from the corresponding quantitative limits for the following year;
- carryover of amounts not utilized in a given year to the corresponding quantitative limit for the following year shall be authorized up to the percentage of the quantitative limit for the year of actual utilization indicated in Column 3;
- transfers from categories 1 to categories 2 and 3 shall be authorized up to the percentages of the quantitative limit to which the transfer is made indicated in Column 4;
- transfers between categories 2 and 3 shall be authorized up to the percentages of the quantitative limit to which the transfer is made indicated in Column 5;
- transfers between categories 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 shall be authorized up to the percentages of the quantitative limit to which the transfer is made indicated in Column 6;
- transfers into any of the categories in Groups II or III (and where applicable Group IV) from any of the categories in Groups I, II or III shall be authorized up to the percentages of the quantitative limit to which the transfer is made indicated in Column 7.

The table of equivalence applicable to the above-mentioned transfers is given in Annex III.

Additional conditions, possibilities for transfers and notes are given in Column 8 of the table.

OPT ADDITIONAL QUANTITATIVE LEVELS

As regards the OPT levels indicated in Annex I (Part 2), the following are the transfers which may be made:

- transfer between categories: 20 per cent of the quantitative level established for the category to which the transfer is made;
- carryover: 10.5 per cent of the quantitative level established for the actual year of utilization;
- advance use: 7.5 per cent of the quantitative level established for the year of actual utilization.
