Dear Ambassador Szepesi,

I am writing further to the notification on 1 March 1995 under Articles 2 and 3 of the Agreement on Textiles and Clothing (ATC), of quantitative restraints maintained by Canada.

That notification inadvertently omitted elements dealing with product and fibre coverage and certain flexibility provisions that were in effect on 31 December 1994. Also omitted were certain restraints on work gloves that were in effect on 31 December 1994 but which were removed on 1 January 1995 under Canada's integration programme; as well as Consultation Levels with one non-WTO Member. Moreover, the notification erroneously indicated a growth rate of 7 per cent rather than 6 per cent in Agreement Item 2 from Bangladesh.

Please find attached (1) an addendum containing the corrections to be made to Canada's 1 March 1995 notification; (2) a summary of Canada's apparel and clothing categories; (3) an addendum that was agreed with Hong Kong and which replicates the 1 March notification in respect of Hong Kong and includes the elements that were omitted from that notification.

ADDENDUM TO TEXTILE NOTIFICATIONS

General Note: an asterisk beside a Category number indicates extended fibre coverage. An asterisk in the Restraint level column indicates that the product is subject to a group Limit.

BANGLADESH

Growth for Agreement Item 2 should read 6%.

Agreement Item 14 excludes categories 14.4 to 14.8.

Agreement Item 3/4a includes Children's garments, sizes 2 to 6x.

Agreement Item 5 excludes splash pants (100% woven nylon fabric, with long legs, elasticized ankles and waist and treated for water repellency).

BULGARIA

Agreement Items 1a and 2 exclude linings of HS headings 61.17 and 62.17.

Agreement Item 3a excludes Children's clothing.

Agreement Item 4 excludes saris.

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

Special swing for 1994 and 1995 of 5% for each year to Agreement Item 2 from any other Agreement Item in Annex I.

Agreement Item 1b (sub-category 1.3) provides a Consultation Level of 100,000 units.

Agreement Item 5 (category 5.0) provides a Consultation Level of 200,000 units.

Agreement Item 7/8a (sub-categories 7.2, 7.3, 8.1) provides a Consultation Level of 125,000 units.

CHINA

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

Agreement Item 7/8b excludes Children's garments.

CZECH REPUBLIC

Agreement Item 3a excludes Children's garments.

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Combined flexibility for Agreement Item 8a is 12%.

HUNGARY

Agreement Item 3a excludes Children's garments.

INDIA

Combined flexibility for all Agreement Items should read 18%.

The conversion factor for Agreement item 41a should read 6.25m²/NMB.

Agreement Item A includes categories 1.2, 2.0, 3.2, 4.0, 5.0, 6.0, 7.0, 8.1 and 8.2.

INDONESIA

Babies' garments are expressed in adult units.

LEBANON

Includes all textile fibres.

LESOTHO

Includes all textile fibres.

MACAU

Swing is allowed between Agreement Items 1, 2, 3a, 5, 6, 11, and 44 only.

Any swing between a restrained product in Group I (Clothing) and a restrained product in Group II (Textiles) will also be reflected in the Group I aggregate restraint.

MALAYSIA

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

Special swing of 7% into Agreement Item 9.

Special swing of 12% on a 1:1 basis, without reference to conversion factors, between Agreement Item 7/8a and Agreement Item 3/4a.

Malaysia shall be allowed to revert back from Agreement Item 14 on a 1:1 basis, without reference to conversion factors, into the following items, up to the limits specified below;

-	into item 5a	up to	5,450 units
-	into item 7/8	up to	50,265 units
-	into item 9	up to	73,307 units
-	into item 11	up to	1,969 units

OMAN

Includes all textile fibres.

Agreement Item 6 excludes children's tailored collared shirts sizes 2 to 3X.

PAKISTAN

The restraints in effect on 31 December 1994 included Agreement Item No. 44; cat 44; Work Gloves and Liners; (PAR) 3,380,186; growth 6%; swing 7%; co/cf 11(6); flex 16% and conversion factor 0.24.

Category 4.2 should be deleted as it was not under restraint on 31 December 1994.

Agreement Item 42a excludes HS code 6302.60.00.19; other toilet and kitchen linen (including bar wipes) of sub-category 42.1.

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

PHILIPPINES

Agreement Items 1b, 3/4a, 3/4b, 5a, and 7/8a exclude Children's garments.

Agreement Item 14 excludes category 14.6.

POLAND

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

Agreement Item 3a excludes Children's garments.

ROMANIA

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

Agreement Items 2/3a and 2/3b exclude Children's garments of categories 3.1 and 3.3.

SINGAPORE

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

Note 1: Agreement item 3a excludes Children's garments

Note 2: Babies's garments are expressed in adult units.

Note 3: Special swing of 10% from Agreement Item 3/4a to Agreement Item 8a, in excess of the combined flexibility.

SLOVAK REPUBLIC

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

Agreement Item 3a excludes Children's garments.

SOUTH AFRICA

Note: Any under-utilization of quantities allocated to items 5, 6 and 7/8a may be transferred to item B, while observing the apparel aggregate A level.

SOUTH KOREA

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

Unlimited swing into Agreement Item 8c from Items 3 and 4.

Babies' garments are expressed in adult units.

Agreement Items 20 and 20a do not include yarns of Category 25 composed of fibres not exceeding 6.35 cm in length.

Agreement Item 30, category 36, excludes cotton fabrics of Chapter 52.

Agreement Item 30c excludes coated fabrics of Chapter 59.

SRI LANKA

Restraints in effect on 31 December 1994 included Agreement Item No. 44a; cat 44.1; Work gloves (PAR) 3,156,422; growth 6%; swing 7%; co/cf 11(6); flex 17% and conversion factor 0.24.

No swing between products in group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

SWAZILAND

The restraint level for Agreement Item 12 was 25,000 units in 1994.

Includes all textile fibres.

Agreement Item 6 excludes tailored collar shirts sizes 2 to 3X.

TAIWAN

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

Item 1a, special swing from Item 8 up to 295,736.

Item 2a, special swing from Item 6 up to 700,000 units.

Category 3.2 includes extended fibre coverage. Agreement Items 3 and 3a exclude Children's garments of categories 3.1 and 3.3.

Agreement Item 4b excludes saris, WG, woven of sub-category 4.3.

Agreement Item 14 is expressed in baby garment units.

Agreement Item 20 includes other yarns of man-made fibres of Headings 54.02, 54.04 to 54.06, 55.09 to 55.11 and 56.04 to 56.06. It excludes filament yarn of polyesters, partially oriented, as described in sub-heading 5402.42. It also excludes yarn other than those solely of any single man-made fibre.

Agreement Item 20, category 23, excludes filament yarn of polyester, partially oriented, as described in sub-heading 5402.42.

Agreement Item 20, category 26, includes other artificial yarns than yarns solely of any single man-made fibre.

No swing between products of Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

THAILAND

For all Agreement Items, the swing is 7%; and the growth rate is 6%.

The conversion factor for Agreement Items 7/8a and 7/8b is 1.7.

There is no limit on combined flexibility, however carryover/forward in combination cannot exceed 10%.

Special swing of 20% from Items 3a and/or 4 to 7/8a.

No swing between products in Group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

Agreement Item 43 excludes MB wool hosiery of category 43.1.

TURKEY

No swing between products of group I (Clothing) and products in Group II (Textiles).

ANNEX II - PREAMBLE

1. Unless otherwise indicated, gender means garments for men (M), boys (B) (sizes 8 to 18), women (W), girls (G) (sizes 7 to 16), children (C) (sizes 2 to 6X) and babies, of a body height not exceeding 86 cm (sizes 0 to 24 months).
2. Unless otherwise indicated, swing is permitted from adult garments to children's and babies' garments at a 3 to 5 ratio.
3. A partially manufactured textile article shall be taken to include an article unfinished or incomplete (including cut or shaped fabric for making such articles), provided that, as presented, the incomplete or unfinished article has the essential character of the complete or finished article. It shall also be taken to include the article presented unassembled or disassembled.
4. Garments of indeterminate gender, including unisex garments, are to be counted as of female gender.
5. Unless otherwise indicated, products covered by restraints under this arrangement in Group I and in Group II are those which predominate by weight of silk, wool, cotton, other vegetable fibres or man-made fibres.

ANNEX II

Hong Kong

1. Unless otherwise indicated, gender means garments for men (M), boys (B) (sized 8 to 18), woven (W), girls (G) (sized 7 to 16), children (C) (sized 2 to 6X) and babies, of a body height not exceeding 86 cm (sized 0 to 24 months).
2. A partially manufactured textile article shall be taken to include an article unfinished or incomplete (including cut or shaped fabric for making such articles), provided that, as presented, the incomplete or unfinished article has the essential character of the complete or finished article. It shall also be taken to include the article presented unassembled or disassembled.
3. Garments of indeterminate gender, including unisex garments are to be counted as of a female gender.
4. Garments made up of different components will be classified according to the component which gives the article its essential character.
5. Unless otherwise indicated, textile garments not meeting the criteria of suits, ensembles, ski suits, track suits, etc., though packed and shipped as a set, are to be classified in the appropriate component items even if put up for retail sale as coordinates.
6. Unless otherwise indicated in Appendix I to the Agreed Record, products covered by restraints under this arrangement in Group I and in Group II are those which predominate by weight of silk, wool, cotton, other vegetable fibres or man-made fibres. Excluded are products of Group I containing more than 85 per cent by weight of vegetable fibres, other than cotton, or more than 70 per cent by weight of silk fibres.
7. The Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (the HS) to which reference is made in this Annex refers to the "Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System" adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council under the International Convention on the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System, done at Brussels on 14 June 1983 as amended by the Protocol of Amendment adopted on 24 June 1986 and to the Explanatory Notes to the Harmonized System including all subsequent amendments approved by the Customs Co-operation Council on or before 31 May 1992.
8. Unless otherwise indicated, swing is permitted from adults garments to children's and babies' garments at a 3 to 5 ratio.
