POST: Statistical Officer

CATEGORY AND LEVEL: Professional - P.1

BASE SALARY: P.1 range: with dependants - US\$26,907.-- to US\$34,610.-- net p.a.
without dependants - US\$25,412.-- to US\$32,481.-- net p.a.

POST ADJUSTMENT:¹ P.1 range: with dependants - US\$26,288.-- to US\$33,814.-- net p.a.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: Fixed-term for two years.

GENERAL FUNCTIONS: The duties, laid out here in general terms, are to be carried out under the guidance of more senior staff and will include:

- assistance in the maintenance and extension of statistical series on merchandise trade by country, commodity and region.
