NOTES TO THE SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT
OF ANTI-DUMPING ACTIONS
SUBMITTED BY CANADA

1 July 1994 to 31 December 1994

1. The symbol (R) is used if an investigation is opened in the context of a review of an existing anti-dumping measure.
2. Provisional measures apply from the date a preliminary determination of dumping is made up to the conclusion of the Canadian International Trade Tribunal's enquiry regarding injury caused to Canadian producers of like goods (maximum 120 days from the preliminary determination date). The percentage represents the estimated margin of dumping of the dumped imports calculated as a percentage of normal value.
3. Either the date of a positive injury finding, in a case of an investigation, or the date of the conclusion of a review of normal values and export prices in cases where there is an existing Canadian International Trade Tribunal finding of injury. The percentage represents the margin of dumping of the dumped imports calculated as a percentage of normal value at the time of the injury finding.
4. The word "Renewal" indicates that an existing undertaking was renewed following a review of the injury question; the word "Amendment" indicates that a technical amendment was made to the undertaking, normally to account for changes in the price or terms contained therein.
5. The trade volume is based on statistical data for the latest available 12-month period prior to initiation except as follows:
 - * 01.01.93 to 30.06.93 (Corrosion Resistant Steel Sheet originating in or exported from Australia, Brazil, France, Germany, Japan, Korea, New Zealand, Spain, Sweden, the United Kingdom and the United States)
 - ** 01.09.93 to 31.08.94 (Fresh, whole, Delicious, Red Delicious and Golden Delicious apples, originating in or exported from the United States of America).
6. As a result of the undertaking review in respect of cast steel grinding balls initiated 07.07.94, Revenue Canada came to the conclusion that the undertaking was no longer required. Accordingly, the undertaking was allowed to expire 11.12.94 thereby terminating all proceedings in respect of the subject cast steel grinding balls.
7. The re-investigation initiated on 13.12.93 in respect of machine tufted carpeting was undertaken in 6 phases with staggered completion dates. The first phase was completed on 28.03.94. Phase 2 was completed on 22.07.94 and Phases 3 and 4 were completed on 30.09.94. Phase 5 was completed on 07.12.94 and Phase 6 was still in progress as of 31.12.94.
8. For purposes of the review of corrosion resistant steel sheet initiated on 12.08.94, exporters were given the option of submitting information in order to obtain specific normal values. Exporters who chose not to submit information received normal values that were based on the margin of dumping found at the final determination. In such cases, normal values were established pursuant to a Ministerial specification in which normal values were determined

as an amount equal to the export price of the goods plus an amount equal to the margin of dumping found for that exporter at the time of the final determination.

At the time of the final determination, the margins of dumping were based on normal values that had been determined using home market prices, constructed values or, on the basis of the best information available, if the exporters had not provided sufficient information to otherwise determine normal values.

Since many of the exporters involved in this review chose not to submit information, normal values were determined using the Ministerial specification. However, for purposes of this report, the method of normal value determination for each of the subject countries continues to indicate the methods used at the final determination since the resultant normal values for the purposes of the review would have been based on the methods used at the time of the final determination.

Note to the Semi-Annual Reports Submitted by Canada
under Article 14:4 of the Agreement

Where an investigation is conducted in the context of a review of an existing anti-dumping measure, the date of completion of the review is shown in column 5, but generally it is not possible to state the margin of dumping in this column. This is because the review procedure was initiated to allow Canadian authorities to determine the current normal value of the imported product, in order to determine, in the future, whether imports of the product are dumped. As the margin of dumping is equal to the difference between the export price and the normal value, it is impossible to determine, *a priori*, the percentage margin of dumping. In addition, Canadian authorities compile statistical data concerning trade volume of the imported product only when reviewing a determination of injury in the context of possible revocation of the anti-dumping measure. As a result, statistical data on trade volume for columns 11, 12 and 13 are not available for investigations of existing anti-dumping measures.
