AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY, ON THE ONE PART
AND THE GOVERNMENT OF DENMARK AND
THE HOME GOVERNMENT OF THE FAROE ISLANDS, ON THE OTHER PART

Notification from the Parties to the Agreement

The delegations of Denmark, on behalf of the Home Government of the Faroe Islands and the European Commission, on behalf of the European Community, have the honour to inform the members of the WTO that the Trade Agreement between the European Community, on the one part, and the Government of Denmark and the Home Government of the Faroe Islands, on the other part, came into force on 1 January 1992.¹ This Agreement contains provisions relating to free trade in goods between the Community and the Faroe Islands in the sense of Article XXIV of the GATT 1994, these provisions being of relevance to the members of the WTO.

Denmark and the European Community are prepared to provide any further information requested by WTO members in respect to the provisions of this Agreement.
