

# Sanitation standard for liquid eggs

## Article 1

This Standard is prescribed in accordance with the provision of Article 17 of the Act Governing Food Safety and Sanitation.

## Article 2

The types of shell eggs can be used for making liquid eggs:

1. The eggshell is intact without cracks.
2. The eggshell is cracked: The eggshell is damaged but the shell membrane is intact, without eggshell surface contamination and contents leakage.

## Article 3

The eggs with broken shell are not permitted for making liquid eggs.

## Article 4

*Salmonella* must not be detected in pasteurized liquid eggs.

## Article 5

The total plate count must be below  $10^6$  CFU/g in unpasteurized liquid eggs.

## Article 6

This standard shall be implemented from 01, 01, 2020.
