6.	<b>Description of content:</b> In order to prevent the introduction of H5N3 Low Pathogenic Avian Influenza (LPAI) virus into Japan, MAFF has suspended the import of live poultry, poultry meat and egg products from the state of Pennsylvania in the United States of America, including those shipped through third countries, since 13 January 2022 based on Articles 37 and 44 of the "Act on Domestic Animal Infectious Disease Control", "Animal Health Requirements for day old chicks and hatching eggs to be exported to Japan from the United States" and "Animal Health Requirements for the poultry meat etc. to be exported to Japan from the United States".
