Description: National Institute of Metrology, Quality and Technology – Inmetro, issued Ordinance No. 71, 22 February 2022 that consolidates technical quality regulation and conformity assessment requirements for automotive components of motorcycles, mopeds, tricycles and quadricycles.

The aim of the consolidation of the regulation is to attend decree No. 10.139 of 28 November 2020.
