<b>6. Description of content:</b> The requirements of the existing standard, SI 62196 part 1, dealing with conductive charging of electric vehicles, shall be declared mandatory. This declaration is inline with the mandatory standardization objective to protect human safety.  This standard adopts the International Standard IEC 62196-1 Edition 2.0: 2011-10. The standard's Hebrew section includes the following national deviations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Changes the normative references (paragraph 2);</li><li>• Changes the references for the conductors' compliance tested within Israel appearing in paragraph 4.2.6;</li><li>• Changes the references for the conductors' compliance tested within Israel appearing in paragraph 31.2;</li><li>• Replaces a paragraph in the informative Annex A.</li></ul>
