<b>6. Description of content:</b> Second amendment to the Mandatory Standard SI 23 part 3, dealing with hinged laminated doors. This amendment changes the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Adds new definitions for maximal deviation, intermediate deviation and abnormal deviation;</li><li>• Changes some of the requirement for materials specified in sub sections 2.1.3-2.1.8;</li><li>• Replaces a specification for a regular door structure (type 1.4.3.1) described in sub-section 2.2.2.1;</li><li>• Changes the allowed deviations described in sub-section 2.3.1;</li><li>• Replaces the different moisture conditions resistance of both sides of the door described in sub-section 3.2.6 (Table 2);</li><li>• Replaces Drawing 3.</li></ul>
